Stout and sturdy, Heat-N-Go is styled with the traditional appearance of a mushroom style heater. Portability in heat had been the single limiting factor in creating a comfortable environment for cooler weather outdoor settings. Whether it's picnicking or tailgating at the ballgame with friends, Heat-N-Go is all that's needed to complement the typical portable equipment like the B-B-Q grill, folding chairs and cooler.

Heat-N-Go is also freedom from the mess of ashes and soot, which is a common nuisance when using transportable fire pits. No more worries about how many logs to bring along or how messy the fire pit will make the trunk of the car. Not only is set up a snap, Heat-N-Go assembles in less than ten minutes, but after letting the heater cool down, Heat-N-Go stows away into it's durable, nylon carry bag for easy transport.

Weighing about the same as a full camping pack, Heat-N-Go's carry bag features a shoulder strap so the entire heater can pack up and be slung over the shoulder to get on the move. Heat output is rated at 21,000 Btu with a run time of approximately 20 hours, more than enough for multiple excursions on a single 20-lb LP tank use.
